It was a busy year at the B. Harley Bradley House. Following a reduced number of visitors in 2020 and 2021 due to the pandemic, we welcomed the ability to re-open in 2022 to a near normal capacity. By the end of November, 963 visitors had toured the house. Events such as weddings, showers, parties, corporate meetings and retreats resumed and resulted in an additional 1,351 people enjoying their unique surroundings. School groups returned for field trips allowing their students to experience the Education Lab. New public events including Sip, Shop & Stroll, Wright at Twilight and our Halloween event, "Mouse in the House" were added, allowing for additional opportunities to share the house, especially with the local residents.
