Holiday Recipe

The following recipe was a staple on the Yesteryear Inn dessert menu. It was furnished to us by Bradley House Volunteer, Rosemary Lamontagne.



In the early 1970's one of Rosemary's

friends was having a birthday party for her husband, who happened to be very fond of the restaurant's Indian Pudding. Rosemary asked one of the Yesteryear waitresses for the recipe. The waitress checked with the kitchen and they willingly gave it to her. Thank you for sharing, Rosemary!

Yesteryear Inn's Baked Indian Pudding

Heat oven to 300° and butter a 1-quart baking dish

Mix together 1/4 cup corn meal, 1 cup cold water and 1 tsp salt. Set aside.

In a large sauce pan, scald 2 cups whole milk. Add cornmeal mixture. Boil and <u>stir constantly</u> for 10 minutes. Remove from heat and add 1 tablespoon butter. Stir until melted.

In large bowl, prepare a mixture of 1 beaten egg, 1/4 cup sugar, 1/2 tsp molasses, 1 tsp cinnamon, 1/2 tsp ginger.

Temper the egg by <u>slowly</u> pouring a small amount of the hot milk mixture into the egg mixture and continue to whisk until all the hot mixture is added. Pour into buttered baking dish. Bake 30

minutes. Stir in 1 cup cold milk. Continue baking for 2 hours. This was served warm (not hot) over a scoop of vanilla ice cream.



Makes 4 servings.
