You can help the B. Harley Bradley House team by volunteering in a number of ways as briefly described below:

- Docents lead historical tours for guests during regular hours and by appointment. Training, including shadowing, is provided.
- Gift Shop Clerks handle merchandise sales, tour tickets, and aid the Gift Shop supervisor to keep the shop running and fully stocked.
- Archives volunteers assist with researching, reviewing, organizing and displaying the various historical documents and artifacts of the house.
- Clerical volunteers work with the office staff producing mailings, filing and general work around the office.

Christmas Decorating

- With the team captain, this group of volunteers decorates the house for the holidays in November and removes them in January.

Education Lab

- Volunteers assist in the Education Lab to provide a unique learning experience for groups grades 3-8.

Special Event Support

- Volunteers assist with a variety of tasks surrounding an event including providing a presence in the rooms of the Bradley House to give brief information and direction. Volunteers can also assist with set-up and take-down of events.
